HOW TO HOST A GREEN EVENT

Hosting a Green Event is simple. Just follow these steps.

Step 1: Identify an individual or team to take responsibility for the recycling program.

Step 2: Contact Green Star (278-7839) for an information packet about the program, including a list of available recycling bins and supplies and the types of materials that can be recycled.

Step 3: Talk with Green Star staff to determine the types and quantities of recycling bins needed and obtain the bins and other supplies from Green Star.

Step 4: Fill out a simple application to ensure necessary communication with Green Star staff.

Step 5: Contact volunteers independently, or with the help of Green Star, to maintain the recycling program throughout your event. Green Star will provide a list of potential volunteers.

Step 6: Determine how materials will be transported from your event to the Anchorage Recycling Center. Pick-up services are available or materials can be dropped off. Contact pick-up services listed below for more information about their services. Prices may be determined at the time of pick-up if exact quantities are not known.

- Recycle Alaska, pick-up: 563-6045
- Anchorage Refuse, pick-up: 563-3717 (larger quantities collected in dumpsters)
- Anchorage Recycling Center, drop-off at 6161 Rosewood St.: 562-2267

Step 7: After completion of the Green Event, simply rinse the bins if needed and return them, along with other borrowed supplies, to Green Star.

Step 8: Provide Green Star with an estimate of the quantities of materials collected for recycling.
